EAST HARTFORD POLICE DEPARTMENT CRIME STATISTICS

Police Chief Mark J. Sirois released Uniform Crime Reporting (UCR) statistics for the 1st Quarter of 2007 which indicated a 23.53% decrease in total Part 1 Crime as measured against the 1st Quarter of 2006.

The 1st Quarter analysis reflects a decrease in total Part 1 Crime (murder, rape robbery, aggravated assault, burglary, larceny, motor vehicle theft and arson) primarily in the area of Larceny. Other categories were mixed.

Reported crime data will fluctuate quarterly but the three year trend in total Part 1 Crime has decreased by 4.42% (2004-2006).

Annual Part 1 Crime has increased by 7.95% for 2006 after decreasing in 2005 by over 11%.

The Chief praised the men and women of the East Hartford Police Department for their dedication and service which makes East Hartford a safer place to live and work. "In partnership with our citizens we are able to work together to resolve quality of life and crime issues that confront our community," stated Chief Sirois.
