On May 24, 2007 at 11:01 AM two armed males entered the Sovereign Bank, at 934 Silver Lane. One of the suspects jumped over the counter, told everyone in the Bank to get down on the floor. Both suspects fled the Bank No injuries reported and an undetermined amount of cash was stolen. A Bank employee vehicle was stolen in the Bank Robbery and was located a short time later on Nutmeg Lane in East Hartford. A Police K-9 was also used in this investigation with negative results.

Suspect: #1 Black male, 5'8" – 5'9" 25-30 years old, 180-190 lbs, gray hooded sweatshirt, blue jeans, black baseball cap, wearing a black mask that covered the nose, mouth and chin.

Suspect: #2 Black male, 5'8"- 5'9" 25-30 years old 180-190 lbs, black hooded sweatshirt, blue jeans, black baseball cap, wearing a black mask that covered the nose, mouth and chin, carrying a silver semi-auto handgun.

The Criminal Investigations Bureau of the East Hartford Police Department processed the crime scene and this investigation continues. Surveillance photographs are being reviewed.
