2010 Road Improvement Program

*2010 Construction Activities
May 2010 thru December 2010*

The Town of East Hartford is advising property owners and motorists that the 2010 Road Improvement Project associated with the Town's Road Improvement Program has been awarded to Tilcon Connecticut, Inc. of New Britain, CT. Construction activities are scheduled to begin in May 2010.

The 2010 roadwork includes: pavement resurfacing/reconstruction, pavement patching, installation of new curbing, manhole adjustments, utility structure adjustments, sidewalk ramp construction, pavement markings, and restoration of disturbed areas. The project is scheduled to be completed by December 2010. The anticipated cost of the project is 2.4 million dollars. The project includes the following streets:

- Collimore Road, Helm Road, and Sedgwick Road
- Burnham Street - from King Street to Route 5 (Ellington Road)
- Goodwin Street - from School Street to Long Hill Street
- Portions of Roberts Street, Hillside Street & Simmons Road

Lane closures will occur throughout the construction period. No road closures or detours are expected during the project. There will be no on-street parking during the construction and paving operations. Motorists are advised to allow extra travel time and use caution while driving throughout the work area.

The Roberts Street segment from the Interstate 84 ramps to east of the Hillside Street intersection will be paved at night. Additional information on the scheduling of night paving operations will be provided as it becomes available.
